PLANNING OUR LIVING ENVIRONMENT

Number of players: 7

BEGINNING OF THE GAME: The town plan is placed in the middle of the table. Role descriptions, together with the proposal cards, are placed face-down near the town plan. Players will take the role cards after the signal given by the game leader. Except for Town planner, whose role will be given to the spokesperson of the table. The game starts with the reading of the text below.

Dear participants,

Thank you all for coming to this town-planning meeting.

As you can see on the plan, there are 3 empty lots in our town, marked as "Wasteland". The goal of today's meeting is to find a purpose for these unused lots and more generally to develop the best future plan for our town.

But, before you start with planning, please agree on and write down the answers to the following questions: how many people live in this town, what is the name of the town and who will be the spokesperson of your table. You have 3 minutes.

Wait ~3 minutes before you proceed.

The spokesperson of your table will lead the meeting and take the role of Town planner.

Give him/her the role.

Now everybody please take a random role, read the text twice, study the town plan and think about your proposals. You have 5 minutes.

Wait ~5 minutes before you proceed.

The Town planner will lead the meeting and he/she will also have the right to decide upon the use of Urban Forest.

Please note that the proposal cards accompanying your role are double-sided and in addition to these I will give every table one "White card", that can be used for completely new ideas or solutions.

Proposal cards should be placed on the town plan. Please bear in mind that the town border equals town plan.

The meeting is scheduled to last 45 minutes. I will keep track and let you know when you are running out of time. At the end of the meeting, I will ask the Town Planner to summarize your agreements. I wish you a productive and creative discussion!

When the first version of the map is ready (~in the middle of the game) make the announcement below:

Dear participants, please note that your town is a health promoting town, which means you must pay attention to:

- Quality of air, food and drinking water;
- Level of noise and light pollution;
- Options for physical activities;
- Environmental protection and waste management.
